

# Ridgeway and Vale Diabetes Expeditions



<b>Title</b>	Oxfordshire Way Stage 2 Linear Walk Sunday 10th June 2018, Christmas Common to Tiddington
<b>Walk</b>	Christmas Common – Pyrton – Adwell – Tetsworth – Rycote - Tiddington
<b>Map Sheets</b>	Map Sheet 1:25,000 OS Explorer Series Sheet 171 – Chiltern Hills West Sheet 180 – Oxford, Witney & Woodstock
<b>Notes</b>	The walk is linear from Christmas Common to Tiddington. For this walk we will all meet at the end point and transfer to the start in a few of the cars, leaving at least one to enable the drivers to be ferried back to the start. Anybody not keen on acting as a taxi please let me know. This is a lovely walk passing through the villages of Pyrton and Tetsworth and hamlets of Adwell and Rycote - famous for its Chapel. A shorter walk can be completed at Adwell, at approximately 6.5 to 7.0 miles, and we can leave a car there.
<b>Start time</b>	Walkers to meet at the Fox & Goat PH in Tiddington OX9 2LH 09.45 am for a 10.00 am start.
<b>Start and Finish</b>	Start - Public Car Park Christmas Common near Watlington GR 702934 Postcode OX49 5HS – Parking is free.  Finish - The Fox & Goat PH in Tiddington OX9 2LH
<b>Difficulty</b>	Leisurely 11.5 miles

<b>Waypoints</b>	Waypoints: Start – From Christmas Common NT car park we follow the path straight down the ridge to Pyrton. We then zigzag our way to Adwell, past an old chapel. After crossing under the M40 to Tetsworth, we ascend Lobbersdown Hill and continue past the Oxford Golf course before reaching Rycote and its Chapel. We then continue to Tiddington - Finish.
<b>Getting there from Aylesbury</b>	<b>Approx 13.5 miles.</b> From Aylesbury follow A418 for Thame, and then on towards Oxford.
<b>Getting there from Oxford</b>	<b>Approx 10 miles.</b> From Oxford take the A40 south towards the M40, taking last exit before M40 for the A418 and cross over the M40 towards Thame. Tiddington is on the A418, approx 1 mile from the M40.
