Getting there from Aylesbury	30 Miles: A41 to Bicester, A34 towards Oxford just past Kidlington see signs for Blenheim Palace & Woodstock, follow A44 under Oxford bypass to Woodstock. 1 Mile after roundabout with A4095 in the town centre turn right into narrow Hensington Road, where the car park is indicated after the Fire Station by the Library, turn left.
